1. QUORUM AND LEAVE OF ABSENCE:

Mr. Ashutosh Manohar was elected as Chairman of the Meeting. He welcomed the Members of Managing Committee and ascertained the quorum of the meeting.

No confirmation on attending the meeting was received from Mr. Suresh Kumar BM, an authorised representative of Karnataka Milk Federation and Ms. Akshali Devendra Shah an authorised representative of Parag Milk Foods Limited. Hence leave of absence was granted to them.

2. TO REVIEW & CONFIRM MINUTES OF THE PREVIOUS MANAGING COMMITTEE MEETING HELD ON 28.06.2019

Signed minutes of the previous meeting held on 28.06.2019 were placed for perusal and the same were read and confirmed.

3. TO UPDATE ON OVERALL POLICY LANDSCAPE, LEGISLATION FROM STATES & ACTIVISM

The Chairman informed the Members of Managing Committee on the changing legislative landscape and business continuity challenges, activism including progress on National EPR framework and update on FSSAI chaired committee for determination on the subject of restriction.

The Members of the Managing Committee apprised that AARC has followed a brand neutral approach to address the straw ban and in the process, AARC has been recognized as an independent and credible voice of the industry.

4. TO REVIEW THE ANNUAL PROGRESS OF AARC

The Chairman informed the Members of Managing Committee on the annual progress and achievements of the AARC for its review. The Chairman requested CEO to share functional details

The Members of the Managing Committee apprised on the active collection of 363 tonnes against a target of 315 tonnes by AARC Members (excluding Coca- Cola).

The Members of the Managing Committee apprised that Schreiber Dynamix, in collaboration with Tetra Pak, has begun a project with Bismillah and Co. and both AARC members aim to facilitate 764 Tons of carton collections spread over three years.

The Members of the Managing Committee apprised that AARC's new member, SIG Combibloc, is starting a project in association with Center for Sustainable Development in Nagpur and aims to facilitate collection of 60 Tons, 90 Tons, and 135 Tons for 2019, 2020, and 2021.

CHAIRMAN'S INITIALS

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5. TO UPDATE ON AARC COLLECTION AND RECYCLING PROJECTS

The Chairman informed the Members of Managing Committee about the collection and recycling projects of AARC along with its ongoing and offered projects.

The Members of the Managing Committee apprised the members that Tetra Pak and Schreiber Dynamix funded three-year project for both awareness and collection component with total volume of 764 MT in Mumbai.

The Members of the Managing Committee apprised that the SIG Combibloc funded three-year project for both awareness and collection component with total volume of 285 MT in Nagpur.

The Members of the Managing Committee apprised that the Society needed members to fund for a three-year project with collection component (awareness optional) with expected volumes 250- 300 MT/100 MT year in Delhi/ NCR and with expected volumes 1000 MT/300 MT year in Pune.

6. TO TAKE NOTE ON REPRESENTATION TO MPCB REGARDING THE PROGRESS IN MAHARASHTRA AGAINST EPR TARGETS

The Chairman informed that the Members of Managing Committee about the representations made to Maharashtra Pollution Control Board regarding the progress made in Maharashtra against the Extended Producer Responsibility (EPR) targets by AARC.

Chairman thanked the members of Taskforce represented by Dabur, Coca-Cola, SDDPL, Tetra Pak and Parle Agro who represented AARC.

The Members of the Managing Committee apprised about the previous interaction with the MPCB cities and targets agreed with the MPCB. It was decided to target three cities (Mumbai, Pune and Nagpur) as they contribute to 92% of carton sales and to begin new Collection Projects in these cities.

The Members of the Managing Committee were apprised that MPCB is not in a position to approve the EPR plans as the authority lies with the Chief Minister's office. However the Chairman, MPCB expressed his happiness on the efforts put in by AARC.

7. TO UPDATE ON COLLECTION AND RECYCLING PLAN IN THE 11 IDENTIFIED CITIES

The Chairman updated the Members of Managing Committee about the collection and recycling plan of AARC in the 11 identified cities.

The Members of the Managing Committee apprised about the rationale behind identifying 11 cities on the basis of sales volume, national importance with respect to plastic waste management and EPR and Business Continuity Challenges emerging from Policy, Activism and State laws.

The Members of the Managing Committee apprised that Coca Cola, Dabur and Parle are also independently enhancing their collection efforts.

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Few members shared their views on exploring the opportunity beyond the identified 11 cities and requested Committee's guidance to expand it accordingly. Therefore, suggestions were invited from the members to explore the opportunity in different cities.

Hence, it was proposed to decide on the final list of identified cities through a Taskforce in the next meeting. Coca-Cola, Dabur, Tetra Pak and SDDPL volunteered to participate in the Taskforce.

It was suggested to get formal approval from the Maharashtra Government for the Maharashtra EPR Plan and to ensure active participation by 3 regional task forces.

8. TO DISCUSS ABOUT THE EVOLVING COLLECTION AND RECYCLING SCENARIO

The Chairman informed that the Members of Managing Committee about the evolving collection and recycling scenario challenges in the new scenario and the PRO system getting abolished.

The Members of the Managing Committee apprised about the active engagement with the MoEFCC related to the National EPR Framework and to monitor developments in UP,

Uttarakhand, Bihar & other States and to engage with more Brand owners to encourage them to join AARC.

9. TO UPDATE ON MEMBERSHIP FEES

The Committee Member informed the Members of Managing Committee about the pending payment from Radico Khaitan and that the payment has been received.

The Members of the Managing Committee were informed that Parle Agro Private Limited has confirmed to pay one time and annual membership fees soon and the same can be noted in ensuing Managing Committee Meeting once the payment shall be made by the Company.

The Members of the Managing Committee were informed of the membership fees due for the

F.Y. 2019-20 from few members and requested to pay the membership fees immediately.

10. TO APPROVE CONSOCIA ADVISORY'S REQUEST TO BE INVITED TO JOIN AS HONORARY MEMBER INSTEAD OF ASSOCIATE MEMBER AS APPROVED IN PREVIOUS MC MEETING

The Chairman informed the Managing Committee that Consocia Advisory are not in position to pay the membership fee for the previous year or the current year. Since Consocia is neither a producer or a brand and not responsible for either collection or recycling, Consocia has requested to become an Honorary member. Hence, Consocia Advisory be inducted as an Honorary Member and their membership fee accrued till date is waived.

Accordingly, the following resolution was passed:

The Members of the Managing Committee approved the appointment of external consultant on need basis at a remuneration of Rs 50,000/- excluding applicable taxes and out of pocket expenses, if any.
